This is to notify you that I presented your Chapter's request to the Certification Board this past weekend.

The Board will agree to the following conditions.

1. The Chapter 11 members seeking amnesty must contribute the time and effort necessary to make the Chapter strong once again. They will do this by becoming the Chapter leadership.
2. The members will be given three years from July 2004 to accomplish this task. They must conduct Chapter meetings, attend Regional meetings and have Chapter representation at the National Conventions.
3. If after the three years the Regional Governor and the BOT deems the Chapter to be active, each member must complete a Continuing Certification Application demonstrating that they have earned the necessary 30 points across the required 3 categories. Participation in the Continuing Certification Program is a requirement of this amnesty.
4. Each member must continue to participate and maintain their membership to retain their Certification. If they do not, no additional opportunities will be given for another amnesty.
5. Each member seeking to enter into this agreement with the Certification Board must individually submit a letter stating their intention to do so.

If for any reason this is not agreeable to any of your membership seeking amnesty, they can always regain their Certification through the re-instatement program, or re-enter the program from the beginning.

I hope this is agreeable to your members and is of help in getting the Sacramento Chapter up and running strong again!
